Please tell us a bit about your company ?

Intuiface is the world's premier platform for creating, deploying, measuring and managing deeply interactive digital experiences *without* writing code. Although Intuiface was launched in 2011, it originates from an older project to develop touchscreens for air traffic control. Easy to understand why the headquarters are in the outskirts of Toulouse, France.

Why did Intuiface choose Chicago?

Being located in Chicago is advantageous because it allows us 3 to 4 overlapping business hours with the French headquarters and it's a nice compromise to the 4 US time zones.

What is the biggest business challenge you've encountered since you've been here?

I work as a Sales Development Representative so my biggest challenge is to be as convincing as any other US SDR. I don't only need to understand our software, processes, customers projects and how I can help him but also deliver it in a way my interlocutor knows he can rely on (and fully understand) me.

What surprised you the most about working in the U.S.?

What surprised me is that there is not much difference between the US and France "work-wise". I guess now most of the business practices are spreading fast. There is however a cultural difference, in my opinion, in the work-life balance: in France you'll hardly ever see someone passing on a vacation day!

On a non-business point of view, I was pleasantly surprised by the kindness of Chicagoans and by the unstressed way of life here: no one fights to get on the 'L', pedestrians don't rush on the sidewalks and people are more likely to engage in conversation with strangers.


TOUT LE MONDE DEBOUT
