






LOCATION OF ALL BIO PHARMA FIRMS




#### DISTRIBUTION INFRASTRUCTURE | GROUND DELIVERY INTERSECTILLINOIS


ILLINOIS HAS TWO MAJOR INLAND PORTS
& 14 WATERWAY PORTS

- 84% of North America's Fresh Water & 21% of the World's Surface Fresh Water
- Access to the Gulf of Mexico & Atlantic Ocean
- Midwest Inland Port is a multi-modal hub that delivers domestic and international flexibility for companies
  - CN, CSX & NS rail lines
  - Connects Midwest to East, West, & Gulf Coasts of North America
  - ADM-owned intermodal rail ramp processing international and domestic containers
- 1K+ miles of navigable waterways
- Shipping via waterways result in an average savings of \$14 per ton, which results in a \$9.2B savings in transportation costs
- THE ILLINOIS PORTION OF THE OHIO RIVER SYSTEM SAVES SHIPPERS MORE THAN \$2B IN TRANSPORTATION COSTS ANNUALLY
- These savings result in more than \$11B in additional output which provide an extra 100K jobs and \$3B in realized income












